"That's what I like about visiting places like Cairns; you find diamonds in the rough and turn them into gold."

Four Australians occupy spots on the current Astros roster while many more play in the professional leagues around the world.

And the local body is doing their best to get their product some exposure to those leagues.

In the last fortnight Cairns trio Brandon Doo, Luke Turner and Daniel Turner toured Japan with a Queensland side hand-picked by Australian baseball legend Dave Nilsson, while local development officer Kevin Johnson took another group to the United States.
